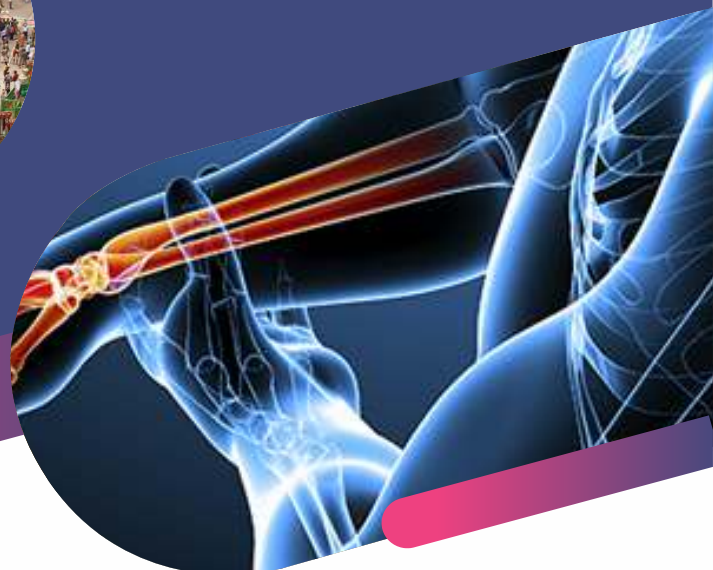

# MESSAGE FROM IPS PRESIDENT & SECRETARY

Dear Friends,

As the president of “Association Of Pelvic Acetabular Surgeons” (AOPAS), I am organising the forthcoming (3rd) annual event of this association at Bhubaneswar from 29th to 31st March, 2019. This meeting is poised to showcase an academic activity of very rich quality over these three days. I have the pleasure in inviting you to join us in this meeting and making it a great success.

Bhubaneswar, a part of the “golden triangle” along with Puri and Konark, is a hub for major tourism activity in eastern India. It offers excellent opportunities for tourists of every interest. This is a place worth visiting with family and friends. It is very well connected to all major cities of India by air, train and road. I personally invite each one of you to come here with your family.

We have invited some of the most outstanding surgeons, known globally for their work and knowledge, from centres of excellence in the USA and South America, as our international faculties. Dr. Henry Saggi from Cincinnati, Dr. Tania Ferguson from Nashville and Dr. Carlo Sancineto from Argentina shall be teaching along with our top national faculties in this meeting.

To add extra value to the meeting, we are trying to organise workshops and cadaveric exercises to suit both beginners and advanced level delegates separately. Finally, we are committed to make the program more interactive with case based presentations, “Meet the Masters” (for an open dialogue with some of the top surgeons of the world), panel discussions with crossfire sessions and competition papers. In addition, Live surgery is on the card for total hip replacement surgery in situations such as for failed acetabular surgery. It shall be demonstrated through a newer MIS approach (direct anterior approach), which avoids going through the old scar of acetabular surgery, thus avoiding surgical difficulties, unnecessary greater morbidity and delayed recovery.

Live surgery through modified stoppa’s approach is planned as well subject to availability of cases during the event. In addition, we are planning to have Pelvic acetabular osteotomy (PAO) as live surgery in dysplastic hips as well. These live surgeries are going to be demonstrated by none other than the current designers of these procedures known for their expertise in these areas, who are our esteemed international faculties in this event.

There are many more innovative teaching modules conceptualised and we shall update you about it from time to time.

Again, expecting a great participation in Bhubaneswar by all our members and their families in this 3rd annual event in March 2019.

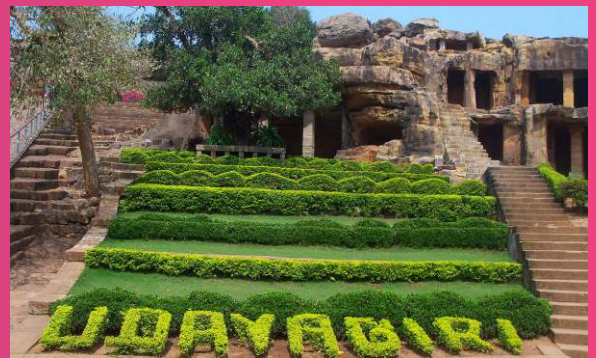
**Day Excursion to Nandankanan**
